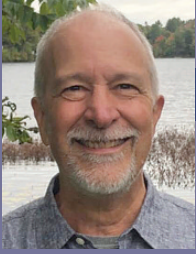

A WORD FROM THE MAYOR

I would like to share with our citizens the history as well as the budget dedicated to the development of Beattie Lake Nature Park. The idea for the Beattie Park project was born in 2009. The land that makes up the vast majority of the Beattie Lake Park is owned by the City of Lachute with Beattie Lake having served as a source of drinking water for the city until about 2009. When Lachute changed its water supply, Beattie Lake and the land surrounding it were at serious risk of being purchased and developed by real estate developers. To protect this jewel and above all, to be able to provide lakefront and over 20 km of trail access to all our residents, the Township of Gore began to negotiate with the City of Lachute for rights to the land. After lengthy negotiations, a 40-year lease costing 1 \$ was signed for full access to the land, thus protecting and creating the Beattie Lake Nature Park.



Since then, the municipality has successfully obtained numerous grants from the provincial government that have been used to develop the park. The grants and financial aid reduce the financial burden of developing the park on Gore residents. Such grants include the FARR which was used to develop the access road, parking lots, docks and reception, the PSSPA used for the development of trails including some in both the Parc des Pionniers and Parc Dénommé, and the PARIT which was used for the development of the rustic accommodations found on site. Other sources of financial aid were sought out to create a washing station for embarkments, to purchase outdoor equipment and to organize fishing initiation days. The total amount of the grants and financial aid received to date is just shy of \$ 800,000.

The park has been open since 2021. Park entrance fees, annual membership cards, outdoor equipment rentals and accommodations (since 2024) generate revenue for the park. So far this year, the park has generated approximately \$ 86,000 in revenue, and the year is far from over. The park's main operating expenses consist of its maintenance (as with all other parks in the municipality) and the salaries of the rangers who ensure the safety of its users.

Events like the "Course Coureur des Bois", which welcomed 160 runners on Saturday, August 24, help promote the park and our municipality.

Beattie Lake Park has become a valuable attraction for our municipality. Seeing Gore families enjoying nature, seeing happy children attending green classes in the park with their teachers and seeing children learn to fish as part of the free "Pêche en herbe" Day really warms my heart. Having a lake without any houses around it, an hour from Montreal, is something very rare that must be preserved.

Finally, we cannot talk about the park without mentioning the many awards received by our team since its creation. The municipality has received awards for the creation and management of the park in addition to the Laurentian Eco-Corridors award under the Community Awareness on the Importance of Natural Environments category for the nature interpretation panels present in the park.

Fall is just around the corner! We invite you to the park to enjoy our 20 km of hiking trails and to admire the fall colours that are slowly appearing at the park. The lake remains accessible and the water sport equipment rental centre is open. Canoes, kayaks and paddle boards are available for rent until the snow arrives. In September, two special events will be taking place at the park: a guided hike starting at 4 pm followed by a 5@7 on Thursday, September 19th and a mushroom picking activity on Saturday, September 28th from 1 to 4 pm.

The mushroom picking activity is an exploration of the wonderful world of mushrooms in their natural environments. You will be shown different species whose characteristics will be described by a mycologist with over 25 years of experience.

Edible mushroom species will be collected according to the rules of the art and cooked upon returning from the walk. Participants will therefore have an opportunity to taste several different species, freshly harvested. To finish off, your guide Guylaine will cook you her favorite dish: mushroom crusts with cream!

YOUR GUIDE: Guylaine Duval has been giving introductory courses on wild mushrooms for over 25 years. She has written several books on wild mushrooms. Her latest creations are: **"Guide d'initiation aux champignons sauvages du Québec"** to learn how to



identify mushrooms, and a first in French in Quebec: **"Champignons médicinaux du Québec"**.

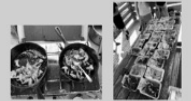

The intercultural gibelotte is a food security component of a program that aims to develop food autonomy among immigrant individuals, families and their host communities. Beyond food assistance, this component offers and supports different alternatives that facilitate access to food in sufficient quantity and quality.

To do this and thanks to food donations, financing, access to premises and more; the organization encourages volunteering, supports social reintegration and collaborates directly with community organizations. Their actions are driven by their values, which are inclusion, respect, teamwork, belonging and development.

This project was created to offer culinary workshops where people of different origins living in the RCM of Argenteuil can share recipes from their countries during collective kitchen workshops.

Their mission is to create links between local populations and immigrant ones, and to encourage social integration through cooking. This initiative aims to create contacts, to create exchanges with the local population and to offer everyone involved a certain independence. Cooking is a very important cultural know-how that remains forever with you, even when immigrating to new areas.

It is a skill that is taken with us wherever we settle in the world. It is something intangible and nothing crosses time and space and breaks down borders and differences better. It is an excellent way to create networks, learn new ways of doing things but above all, to integrate into society and break the social isolation.

The project responds to the need for integration and social inclusion of immigrant people and their families within the community and breaks their isolation. The fight against poverty is another priority addressed by the project. The distribution of the food created will allow low- and middle-income people to feed themselves and discover recipes from various origins.
