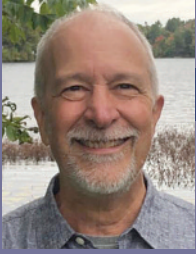

A WORD FROM THE MAYOR

Dear fellow residents,

In 2021, the municipality adopted a Special Planning Program (SPP), which is a planning document that specifies the intentions of a municipality regarding a part of its territory. It allows municipalities to focus on certain sectors that require particular attention. Our SPP was done for the "Lakefield" sector which includes the town hall, church and community center, fire hall and municipal park. Today, I am happy to announce that the municipality completed negotiations and recently purchased some strategic land and buildings for the future of our community, buildings and land included in our SPP. The famous Petro T lot on the corner of Braemar and the 329 was purchased for \$400,000 and has roughly \$150,000 worth of gravel on the site which was included in the sale. This gravel will be used for municipal projects such as road maintenance and upkeep. It is obviously a strategic site as it is in the center of the municipality between two major collector roads and Route 329.



As well, the municipally purchased our historical Holy Trinity Church, the Shrewsbury cemetery, the Holy Trinity cemetery and last but not least our community center for a total of \$75 000. We had been previously leasing the Community Center for a dollar a year from the diocese and received grants over the years which were used to renovate the center. The history of GORE will be protected. These purchases will allow the municipality to apply for grants to increase services of proximity to our residents. While there are no short-term plans for big projects, it is important for a municipality like ours to plan for the long term and these sites provide many possibilities for the future.

I take this opportunity to thank all the volunteers who worked tirelessly to maintain the church and its surroundings (including the cemetery). Without their work and dedication, the church would not be in such a good state. Many people put their heart into the conservation of this important heritage site. Also, throughout the years, many residents were helped by the church with generous donations that supported them through ruff times. The church volunteers also contributed greatly to our community with the Christmas baskets fund. There are no words strong enough to express my gratitude to these volunteers.






Fire safety tips for summer!

The arrival of summer means plenty of opportunities to have fun outside with family and friends. Here are some tips to protect yourself against the risk of fire and injury.

Whether it is to burn dead leaves, eat marshmallows in good company or any other reason, you must obtain a fire permit. To obtain a fire permit, you must call **514-754-3473**.

The SOPFEU fire danger is a good indicator for adapting your behavior according to each level. Check the municipality's fire danger on the SOPFEU website: <https://sopfeu.qc.ca/>.

Please note that fire permits are issued on a day-to-day basis, and only when fire risk conditions are low or moderate.

Campfire Dos and Don'ts

- Always set up your campfire where there is no risk of spreading – far from tents, trailers, dry grass, leaves, hanging tree branches or anything else that could catch fire.

- Never use gasoline to start a fire and, above all, never add it to flames, as they could follow the jet to the container you are holding.
- Have water and a shovel nearby to put out the fire when you no longer need it.
- Always put out your campfire with sand AND water.

Using an outdoor BBQ

- Never use a barbecue indoors or in an enclosed space – this exposes you and your family to the risk of fire, as well as dangerous and toxic gases.
- Place your barbecue well away from any combustible objects or materials such as decks, fences, or plants.
- Never leave a lit BBQ unattended.
- Check your propane tanks and supply lines to make sure they are installed properly, then clean the drip tray regularly.

Home security in summer and all year round:

- Test your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors and replace batteries if necessary.
- Make sure your fire extinguishers are in good condition.
- Make sure that everyone in the house knows the evacuation plan in the event of a fire in your home or building.
- Ensure that windows and doors to be used in the event of a fire are free of obstructions and open easily.

Conservation Lakefield protects 35 hectares in Gore

Conservation Lakefield is extremely proud to announce the acquisition of 35 hectares (86.5 acres) of natural habitat in Gore. This purchase, completed in December 2023, is our second notable acquisition, bringing the area of natural forests and protected wetlands in the Lakefield Domain to more than 152 hectares (375 acres). The properties belonging to Conservation Lakefield thus constitute the largest protected area in the Township of Gore and one of the largest in the MRC d'Argenteuil.

The acquired natural habitat, in the heart of our region, will be protected and conserved in perpetuity, preserving habitats for wildlife, rich floral diversity and connectivity with neighboring natural environments.

This conservation project was made possible thanks to the financial support of the Government of Canada through the Natural Heritage Conservation Program (PCPN), the Government of Quebec with its Partnership for Natural Environments (PPMN) project managed by the Fondation de la Faune du Québec, the Fondation Écho, as well as by the immense generosity of several local citizens.

We are extremely grateful to the many volunteers who helped save these natural environments from the pressures of residential development. We look forward to working with our community again soon as Conservation Lakefield continues its mission to protect natural environments in the region. We keep in mind the national objective of 30% protected areas in 2030. Be on the lookout

PUBLIC WORKS

CAMBRIA ROADWORK PROJECT

At the beginning of the year, the municipality received a grant of more than 5 million dollars to repair Cambria Road (8.8 km). Following the call for tenders process, a contract was awarded to Desormeaux Excavation, which began the repair work on April 29th. The work will last approximately 16 weeks and will include the following stages (in chronological order):



- 1- Removal and pulverization of existing asphalt and large underlying rocks
- 2- Changing of road culverts and certain private driveway culverts
- 3- Cleaning and remodeling of ditches
- 4- Excavation and reprofiling of the road in certain areas
- 5- Adding new granular material and installing the geogrid
- 6- Asphaltting and road shoulders stabilization.
- 7- Installation of guardrails.

Cambria Road will remain open to local traffic for the duration of the work but delays and slowdowns are expected. If you can, choose another route for your travels.

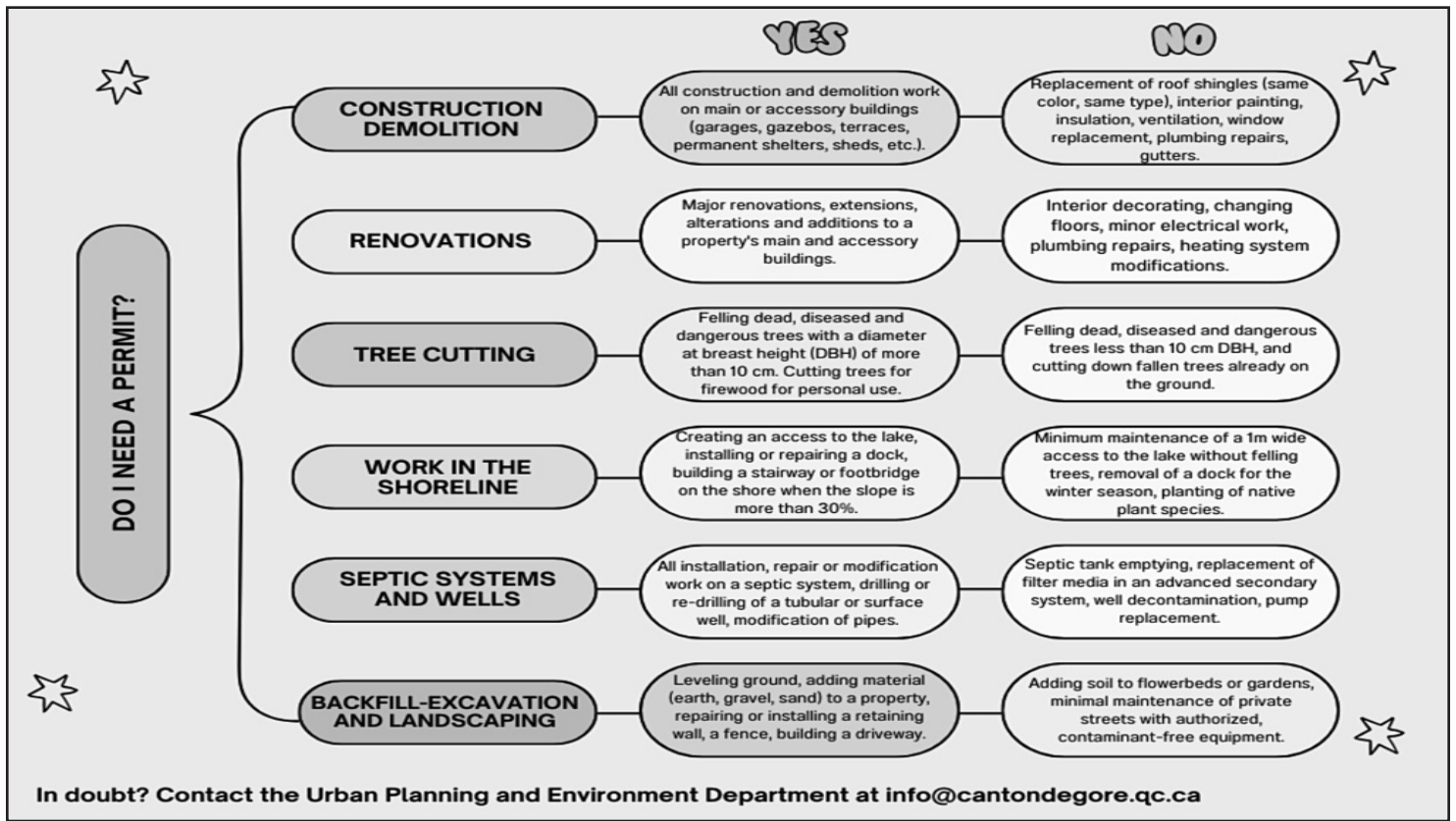
